## CLIENT SERVICES: THE SUIT IS JUST THE BEGINNING

When a woman walks through our doors for the first time to get an interview suit, she may be unsure of herself or what we can offer. She might fear that she will be judged. But when a woman sees herself in the mirror, perhaps wearing the first suit she's ever had, her face lights up and we can see a change in how she feels about herself and about us. The clothing that Dress for Success Cincinnati provides for the women referred to us is not a reward or prize; it symbolizes our confidence in every woman's potential to succeed. *Her journey has just begun.*

### Suiting Program: Interview Suits

Dress for Success Cincinnati became renowned for providing suits to women returning to or entering the workforce. Although our mission has expanded, the suiting program remains a crucial part of our work and a vital first-step in a woman's journey toward self-sufficiency.

Each client receives a suit and accessories for job interviews and an additional week's worth of work-appropriate apparel when she becomes employed.

After referral by one of our 100+ partner agencies, or by our new self-referral option, each client works one-on-one with a Personal Shopper to select her initial professional attire. Our personal shoppers also surround each woman with encouragement and care.

### Career Center: Job Search Guidance

Our clients come from varied backgrounds, many of which are underprivileged. They often do not have access to a computer, printer or the Internet outside of our Career Center, so it promotes their professionalism and their confidence. The career guidance they receive here and their new technology skills are crucial competitive-edge resources for getting a job and advancing their careers.

Staff members and volunteers work one-on-one with clients helping them to create superior resumes and cover letters, providing career counseling and mock interviews and facilitating access to professional skills training courses.

### Mobile Services: Dress for Success Cincinnati on the Road

Dress for Success Cincinnati goes where the need is and the women are. Our Mobile Career Transformation Center (MCTC) allows us to take our full complement of suiting services to women across the Greater Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky region.

Many women have difficulty reaching our location in downtown Cincinnati. But the MCTC takes our suiting services and resources to our non-profit partner agencies across 12 counties.



Time between interview suiting and an offer decreased from an average of 54 days in 2016 to 31 days in 2017.



### **Going Places Network: Job Readiness**

When a woman needs a job or a better job, our Going Places Network can make the difference between being stuck and moving ahead.

Our GPN series helps unemployed and under-employed clients gain professional skills and build confidence through weekly training sessions covering key topics, one-on-one career coaching and networking in a supportive peer environment.

### **Professional Women's Group: Career Building**

Success is not only about getting a job; it's about building a career. Our programs help our hardworking clients navigate this daunting change.

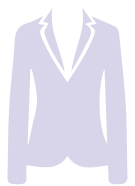
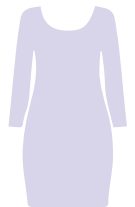

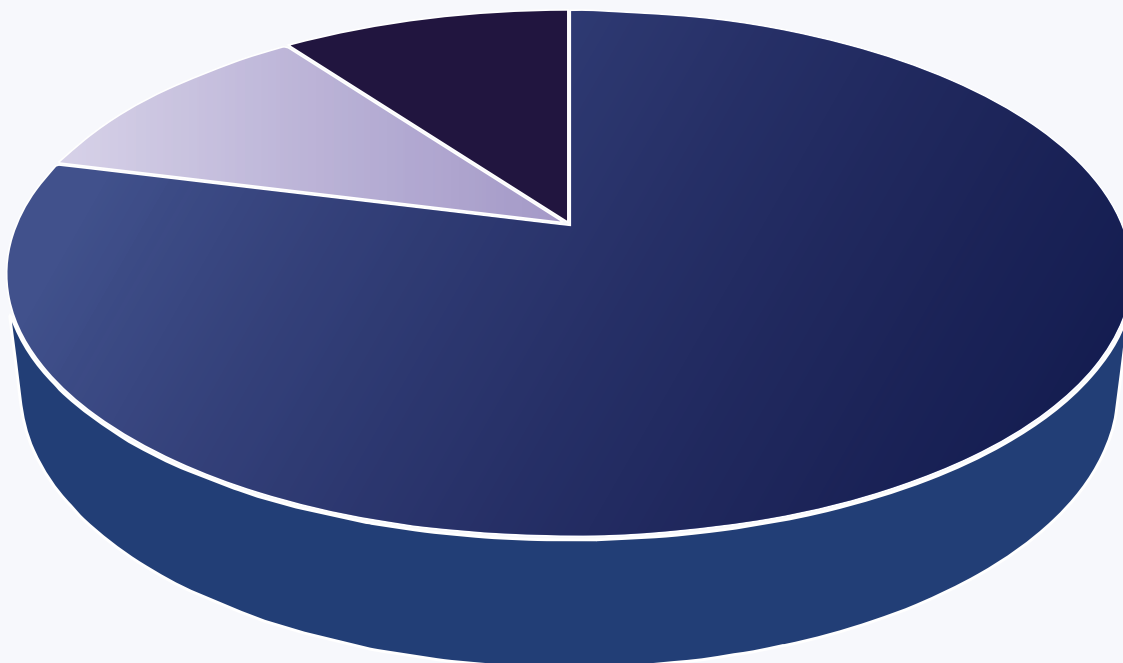
